Defendant-Intervenors Dennis Hollingsworth, Gail J. Knight, Martin F. Gutierrez, Hak-Shing 2 William Tam, Mark A. Jansson, and ProtectMarriage.com – Yes on 8, A Project of California 3 Renewal ("Defendant-Intervenors") moved under this Court's Civil Local Rule 7-11 for an order 4 permitting them to file a motion for summary judgment with a 100-page long memorandum of points 5 and authorities in support. Doc #172. The motion for administrative relief is opposed by the 6 Plaintiffs. Doc #174.
