United States District Court For the Northern District of California The ACLU and Equality California ("objectors") move for a stay of the court's March 22, 2010 order, Doc #623, as they intend to appeal the order or alternatively to seek a writ of mandamus. Doc #624. Objectors state that they intend to seek review on "an extraordinarily expedited basis." Id at 3. As an alternative to a stay pending appeal, objectors move for an interim stay while they seek appellate relief. Id at 7.

8 Having considered the arguments presented by objectors,
9 the court GRANTS the motion for an interim stay. The court's March
10 22 order, Doc #623, is STAYED until March 29, 2010 to allow
11 objectors to seek relief in the court of appeals.
