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I, Elizabeth Gill, a Staff Attorney at the American Civil Liberties Union of Northern California ("ACLU-NC"), have personal and first-hand knowledge of the facts set forth in this Declaration and, if called as a witness, I could and would testify competently these facts under oath.

- 1. On behalf of Our Family Coalition, Lavender Seniors of the East Bay, and Parents, Families, and Friends of Lesbians and Gays (collectively, "Proposed Intervenors"), ACLU-NC, along with Lambda Legal Defense and Education Fund, Inc. and the National Center for Lesbian Rights, today filed a Motion to Intervene in this action.
- 2. Upon learning through the Court's June 30, 2009 Order and the July 2, 2009 case management conference of the possible need for evidentiary presentations concerning certain factual issues of enormous importance to Proposed Intervenors and their members and to the lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender community generally, Proposed Intervenors filed their motion to intervene as soon as reasonably practicable.
- 3. According to the schedule for Chief Judge Walker posted online, the first available law and motion hearing date is September 3, 2009. Also according to the schedule posted online, Judge Walker is unavailable from July 20, 2009 through July 24, 2009.
- 4. Proposed Intervenors seek to intervene in this action in part based on their and their counsel's experience and expertise on the factual issues presented in the case. Their exclusion from the parties' preparation of a joint case management conference statement, due on August 7, 2009, and from a second case management conference set for August 19, 2009, would compromise their ability to participate effectively in the action.
- 5. In order to be able to participate fully in the parties' August 7, 2009 joint case management conference, Proposed Intervenors request in their Motion to Shorten Time the following expedited schedule for opposition to and hearing on the Motion to Intervene: any opposition to the Motion to Intervene must be filed no later than July 14, 2009; a reply, if any, in support of the Motion to Intervene must be filed no later than July 16, 2009; and a hearing on the Motion to Intervene set for July 17, 2009, or on such other date as the Court may set (hereinafter "Expedited Schedule").
- 6. On July 7, 2009, Mark Rosenbaum, Legal Director of the ACLU of Southern California, contacted counsel for Plaintiffs Theodore Boutros and sought the consent of Plaintiffs

both on the Motion to Intervene and the Expedited Schedule. On July 8, 2009, I am informed and believe that a colleague of Mr. Boutros's contacted Mr. Rosenbaum and informed him that Plaintiffs would oppose the Motion to Intervene, and that they were not taking a position on the Expedited Schedule until they had seen the Motion.

- 7. On July 7, 2009, Mr. Rosenbaum contacted counsel for Defendant-Intervenors Charles Cooper and sought the consent of Defendants Intervenors both on the Motion to Intervene and the Expedited Schedule. Counsel for Defendant-Intervenors indicated that Defendant-Intervenors would oppose the Motion to Intervene, and he also said indicated that he could not consent to the Expedited Schedule but that he would propose an alternative schedule.
- 8. On July 8, 2009, Jennifer Pizer, National Marriage Project Director of Lambda Legal Defense and Education Fund, Inc., contacted Tamar Pachter, Deputy Attorney General, counsel for Defendant Attorney General Edmund G. Brown and sought the consent of the Attorney General both on the Motion to Intervene and the Expedited Schedule. Counsel for Defendant Attorney General Edmund G. Brown responded that she would communicate our request to her colleagues and provide a response as soon as practicable.
- 9. On July 8, 2009, Ms. Pizer contacted Kenneth C. Mennemeier, counsel for Defendant Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger, and sought the consent of the Administration on both on the Motion to Intervene and the Expedited Schedule. Counsel for Defendant Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger responded that he would communicate our request to the Administration and advise us upon receiving the Administration's response.
